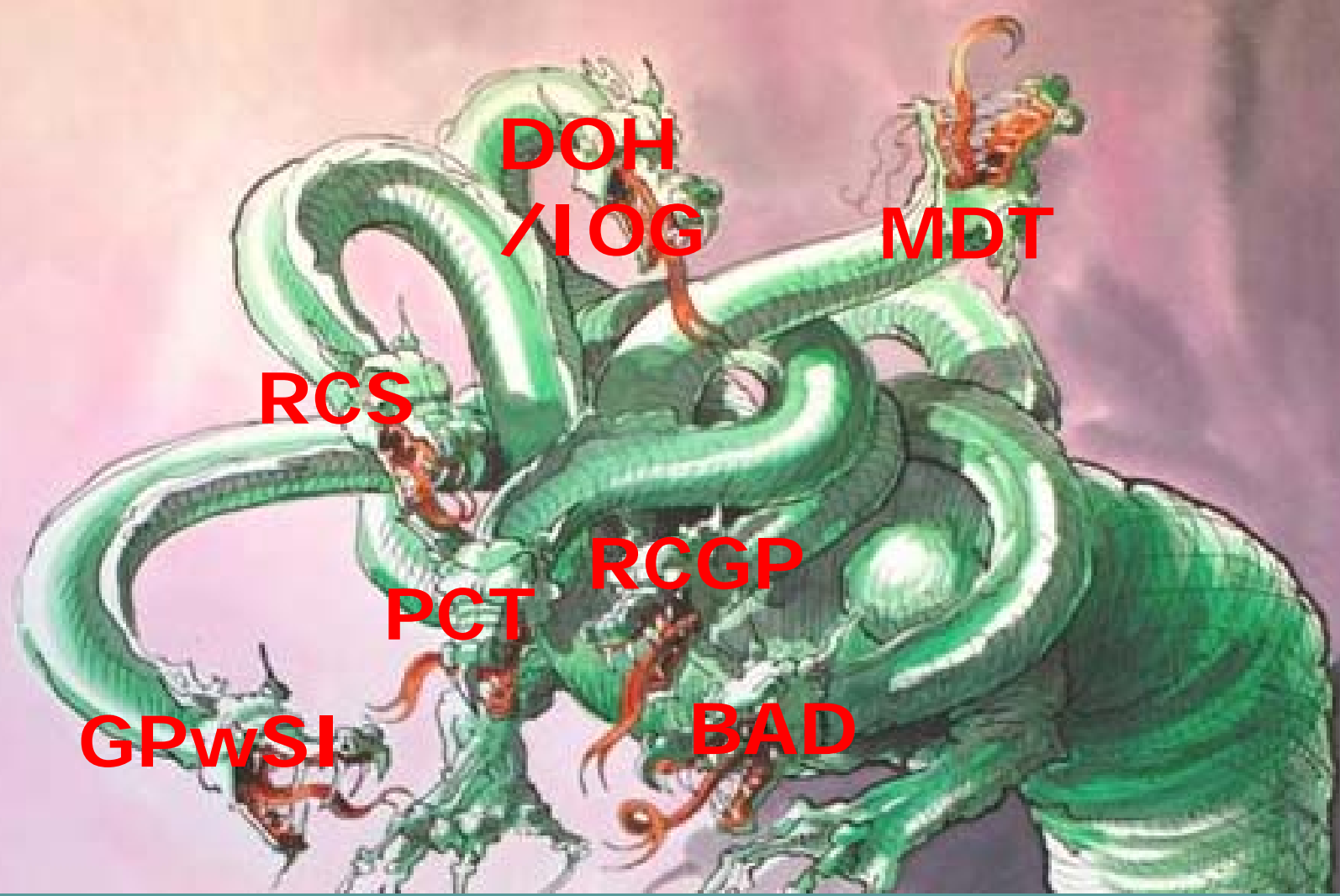

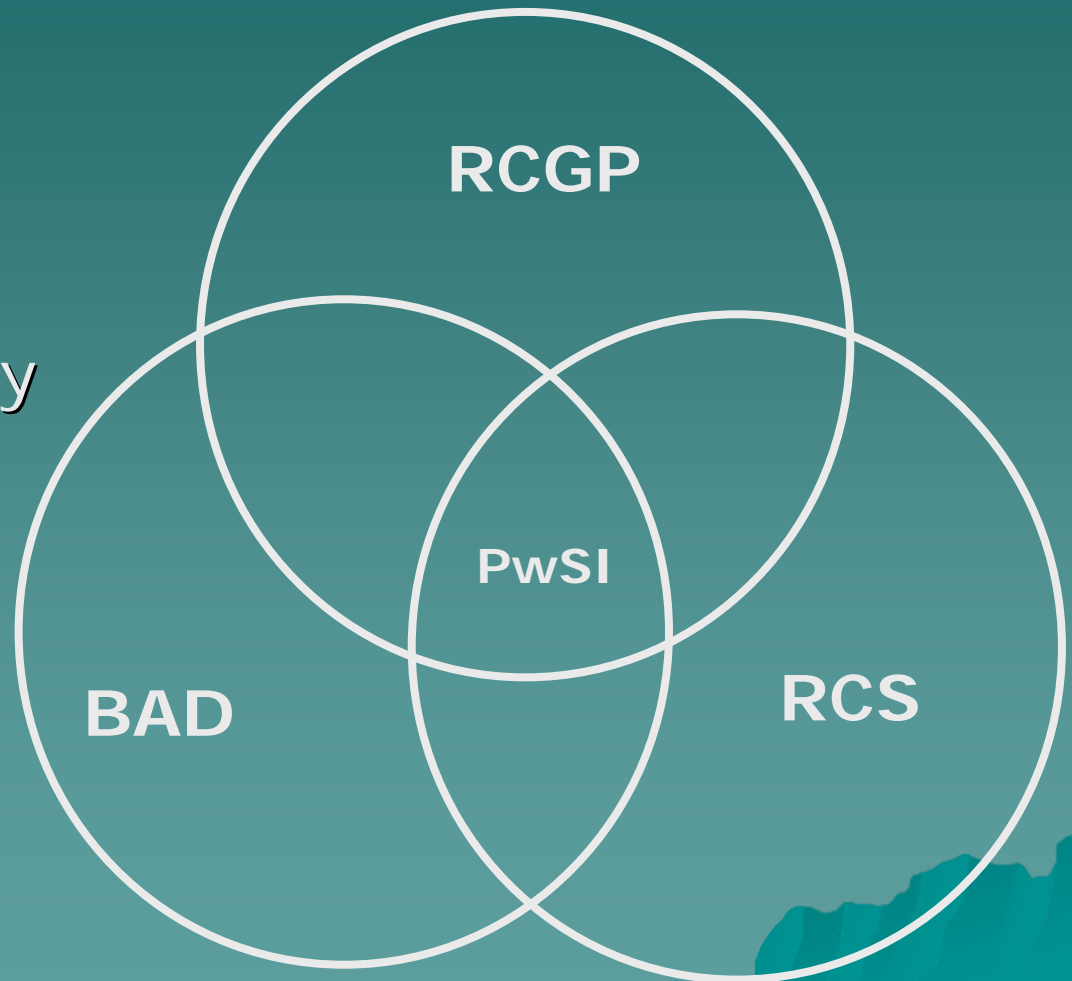

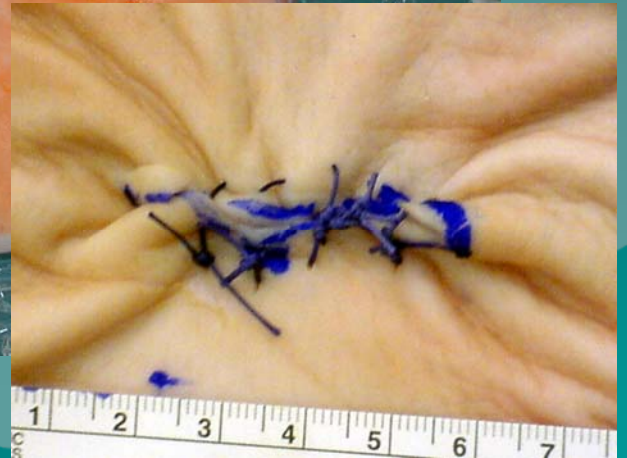

◆ Strength

- ◆ 40 BCCs/year
- ◆ Integration
 - MDT
- ◆ Audit
- ◆ Education

◆ Weakness

- ◆ 40 BCCs/year
 - Quality, not quantity
- ◆ “Low risk”
 - Head & neck
- ◆ No skills assessment
- ◆ Patient choice

◆ Opportunity

- ◆ Joint working
- ◆ Training posts
- ◆ Private practice
 - To patients
 - To insurance Co

◆ Threat

- ◆ Central control
- ◆ Private providers
- ◆ Indemnity
- ◆ Consultant income
